February Special Offering

Special offerings are collected each month to benefit charities outside the Church. A different charitable organization is chosen each month, and the February special offering will support the Free Medical Clinic of Oak Ridge. The Free Medical Clinic provides no charge medical care for low-income and uninsured residents of Anderson, Morgan, and Roane Counties of Tennessee. Since its opening in 2010, with many volunteers from our church, it has grown to provide three clinic locations in Oak Ridge, Briceville, and Harriman. Since this time the Free Clinic has provided over 50,000 patient encounters and 30 million dollars worth of primary medical care to community members. The Free Medical Clinic is the only healthcare facility that many of our neighbors have to help them with their medical care.
