Steve Herbes will lead this in-person gathering for anyone in the area who desires to participate. The seven-week group will be held from 6:30 to 8:00 pm. The group will provide persons an opportunity to understand the grief experience and a safe, supportive community in which to express and explore their grief. The group is limited to 8 people and will not meet on Monday, July 4. It is open to those who lost their loved one in the last year, or perhaps years earlier. “The Bible For Critical Thinkers” Begins Again

Rev. Mark Flynn will soon begin the last phase of his 39-week “The Bible For Critical Thinkers” study. This seven-week study will cover the non-gospel books of the New Testament, with chapters on Holy Spirit, Sovereign One, Salvation, Church, Spiritual Gifts, Spirituality, and Everlasting Life.

Participants will be provided a free study booklet (electronic version and/or paper copy) with daily readings and will have two live-discussion options. On Monday evenings beginning June 13, an online class led by Rev. Mark will meet from 7-8 pm. On Wednesday mornings beginning June 15, he will lead an in-person class in the Fellowship Hall from 10-11 am.
