### **Special Offering Summary for First Things**

Special offerings are collected to benefit organizations outside our Church. For July, Aid to Distressed Families of Appalachian Counties (ADFAC) has been chosen. ADFAC serves families struggling with poverty, offering household assistance and school supplies to children in need. Financial assistance ranges from aid for utilities and rent to building materials for home repairs, as well as down payment assistance for new homeowners. Supportive efforts include budget coaching, financial literacy, home ownership readiness, and referrals to other area resources. The School Supplies Program works directly with thirty-nine schools to determine the students in need as well as the specific supplies requested by each school. ADFAC answers over 6,000 requests for assistance each year.
